

Utica's Gasoline Alley

Rules & Regulations

ALL PARTICIPANTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, VEHICLE REGISTRANTS, GUESTS, AND VENDOR SPACE OCCUPANTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS.

CAR GUIDELINES

- Car spaces shall be used for vehicle showing only
- Aisles must remain completely open
- Unloading of vehicles on premises is prohibited on show days
- Additional parking for tow and support will be available.

COMPLIANCE & ENFORCEMENT

Utica's Gasoline Alley and the City of Utica reserve the absolute right to regulate conduct, restrict any and all activities, and restrict the possession of any and all items, at their sole discretion. Utica's Gasoline Alley and the City of Utica reserve the absolute right to remove any and all persons from the event for failure to abide by any and all rules and regulations specifically set forth herein, or, instructions issued from time to time by, it's employees, and/or designated agents. Furthermore, in the event of a possible violation of the laws of the State of Michigan, Utica's Gasoline Alley and the City of Utica reserve the right to detain persons suspended of such violations, until such persons can be turned over to the custody of local law enforcement personnel.

CREDENTIALS MISUSE

Misuse of any show credentials may result in ejection from the Utica's Gasoline Alley event premises.

DISABLED GUEST SERVICES

Disabled guests are welcome to enter with their own wheelchairs and three or four- wheeled electronic convenience vehicles (ECV).

GENERATORS

Generators may be safely operated between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. The use of generators at any other time is strictly forbidden. Generators causing excessive noise or fumes are strictly prohibited. Generators that vent exhaust fumes directly into adjoining vendor spaces are strictly prohibited. Generators should be vented above vehicles and crowd.

MERCHANDISE RESTRICTIONS

The sale of knives, guns, martial arts weapons, etc. is prohibited. The sale of ammunition, fireworks, adult items, and drug paraphernalia is explicitly prohibited.

NOISE RESTRICTIONS

TV's, radios, stereos, loudspeakers, wireless speakers, etc. shall not be operated in such a manner to disturb others.

PETS

Due to health and safety reasons, pets are strongly discouraged from this event. If your pet must be present, it must be on a leash at all times, and policing after it is required. Your pet must be under your control all times and you are fully responsible for its actions. Any offensive or unsafe actions by your pet may result in expulsion without refund.

REFUNDS

Sorry, no refunds.

RIGHT TO REJECT APPLICATION FOR SPACE RENTAL OR RENEWAL

Utica's Gasoline Alley reserves the right to reject any application for space rental or renewal on the basis of unsatisfactory previous conduct, merchandise that does not fit within the scope of the event, or upon any other basis made in the sole determination and at the sole discretion of Utica's Gasoline Alley. Utica's Gasoline Alley also reserves the right to remove individuals who exhibit unsatisfactory behavior during the event.

SALES TAX

The State of Michigan requires that any vendor selling merchandise obtain a permanent Michigan sales tax license.

SECURITY

Security is not provided. All participants are responsible for their own property, i.e. vehicles, parts, merchandise, etc.

SET-UP AND TEAR-DOWN

Set-Up

Official set-up day is Friday before the event.

Tear-Down

All vendors are required to remain on grounds until 5 p.m. Saturday. Tear down must be concluded by 3 p.m. on the Sunday following the event. No equipment of any kind may be stored on site between events.

SPACE POLICY- Occupancy, Transfer, and Subleasing

INTENT OF POLICY

The policies of which outline the conditions for occupancy are intended to uphold the integrity of the event. It is our goal to provide the community with an appropriate and diverse product line from our vendors.

TRANSFER OF SPACE

All vendors must have authorization from Utica's Gasoline Alley in order to transfer vendor spaces. Utica's Gasoline Alley reserves the right to approve any and all transfer requests at its sole discretion.

OCCUPANCY/ SUBLEASING OF SPACE AND REFUND POLICY

At this time, there will be no subleasing of vendors spaces allowed. Sorry, no refunds.

SPACE USAGE RESTRICTIONS

Swap meet spaces shall be used for parts, cars, accessories, etc., only. Merchandise for sale must be a minimum of 80% automotive. All merchandise, vehicles, and tent stakes must be contained within the assigned space. Vendors may not engage in any sales or business activities outside of the assigned space without written consent from Utica's Gasoline Alley.

TRANSPORTATION ON- GROUNDS

Vendors will be allowed to use bicycles, two-wheeled scooters, golf carts, ATV's, motorcycles, mini bikes, or other forms of personal transportation on- grounds only between the hours of 4 p.m. and 7 a.m. on show days. Use between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. by anyone on show days will be strictly prohibited. Operation of such vehicles by unlicensed drivers is prohibited at any time. Verification of insurance is required.

Vehicular traffic is strictly prohibited on show days between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m.

TRASH REMOVAL

Vendors will be charged for removal of excessive trash that is not properly bagged at the discretion of the City of Utica. It is mandatory that cardboard boxes be broken down and neatly stacked.

VEHICLE PARKING

Any vehicle that is found illegally parked may be towed at owner's expense without any paging, announcement, or notification.
